UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF A FRAUDULENT IDENTIFICATION CARD 10-05470

Wood Dale, IL – The Wood Dale Police Department opened an investigation into the alleged production of fraudulent Illinois and United States Government identification cards, including Driver's Licenses, Social Security Cards and Resident Alien Cards at a local business. During the investigation, the Wood Dale Police Department obtained evidence to obtain a search warrant for a business identified as Rumors II Hair Salon at 301 E. Irving Park Road, Wood Dale. The search warrant was executed in the afternoon hours of May 18th without incident.

Upon conducting a search of the business, evidence was seized relating to the possession and manufacturing of fraudulent identification cards that were allegedly supplied to members of the community who paid for them.

Juarez was charged with two counts of Unlawful Possession of a Fraudulent Identification Card, class 4 felonies punishable by 1 to 3 years in the Illinois Department of Corrections and a fine of up to \$25,000. He was transported to the DuPage County Jail for a bond hearing, where his bond was set at \$5,000.
