### **PRESS RELEASE**

#### **DUI Arrest**



**Wood Dale, IL** - On Saturday, November 23rd, 2013 at approximately 8:40 p.m. the Wood Dale Police Department received a 911 call to its dispatch center. The caller, a concerned citizen, related that he observed a Honda SUV committing several dangerous violations including U-turns into oncoming traffic and running red lights.

Officers were dispatched to the area where they located the Honda still committing dangerous violations. The vehicle was stopped and the driver identified as 60 year old Grigor Rosco of Chicago. Rosco submitted to field sobriety tests which he failed. Rosco was placed under arrest and taken to the Department for processing. Rosco's Honda was towed and impounded. Rosco was given a breath test that resulted in a BAC of 0.233.

The arresting Officer in this case was assigned to an Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) DUI patrol. This patrol was funded by IDOT to target and arrest impaired motorists on Illinois roadways. The resident who reported the alleged drunk driver was submitted to the Alliance Against Intoxicated Motorists Drunk Buster program for a \$100.00 reward.

The Department charged Rosco with:  
Driving under the influence B.A.C over .08  
Disobeyed a traffic signal  
Operation of an uninsured vehicle

The Department reminds everyone that it is dangerous and a crime to drink and drive.

Members of the public are reminded that these complaints contain only charges and are not proof of the defendant's guilt. A defendant is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair trial in which it is the government's burden to prove his or her guilt beyond a reasonable doubt.
