H. This CONTRACT, made and entered into this_day of _, 2022, by and between the CITY OF WOOD DALE, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter "City"), and Dehm Ewiter Ortular Juc., an Illinois corporation (hereinafter "Contractor");

WHEREAS, the City desires to engage the Contractor to provide (hereinafter "Work"), located within the corporate limits of the City of Wood Dale; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor represents itself to be in compliance with Illinois Statutes relating to all matters affecting its status as a corporation operating as a general contractor within the State of Illinois and to have the necessary expertise and experience to furnish such services for the Work upon the terms and conditions set forth herein below:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, it is hereby agreed by and between the City and the Contractor that:

I. SCOPE OF SERVICES

- K. Bid-rigging is a Class 3 felony. Any person convicted of this offense shall be barred for 5 years from the date of conviction from bidding on any contract offered for bid by any unit of State or local government.
- L. Sec 33E-4. Bid rotating. A person commits the offense of bid rotating when pursuant to any collusive scheme or agreement with another. He engages in a patter over time (which, for the purposes of this Section, shall include at least 3 contract bids within a period of 10 years, the most recent of which occurs after the effective date of this amendatory Act of 1988) of submitting sealed bids to units of State or local government with the intent that the award of such bids rotates, or is distributed among persons or business entities which submit bids on a substantial number of the same contracts. Bid rotating is a Class 2 felony. Any person convicted of this offense shall be permanently barred from bidding on public contracts in the State of Illinois.
