

Aggravated Child Pornography

Wood Dale, IL – This press release is a follow up investigation resulting from an incident that occurred in August of 2011.

The Wood Dale Police Department executed a search warrant during the afternoon of August 11, 2011 at 271 N. Oakwood. The purpose of the search was to obtain evidence of the production and possession of explosives and explosive devices.

The search warrant was executed without incident by Wood Dale Police, Bureau of Alcohol Tobacco & Firearms, DuMeg, and the DuPage County Bomb Squad.

A search of the residence also uncovered evidence of child pornography in the form of hundreds of photos and movies. Some of the children depicted were under 13 years of age. The evidence was presented to the DuPage County State's Attorney's Office who subsequently approved a charge against the offender in this case, Bryan Roehr, for Aggravated Child Pornography. Mr. Roehr is currently awaiting trial for his involvement on Possession of Explosives and Criminal Damage to Property from an earlier case. Aggravated Child Pornography is a Class 2 felony and is punishable up to seven years in the Illinois Department of Corrections and up to a \$25,000 fine.
