APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL FROM JENSEN'S PLUMBING AND HEATING FOR THE CITY HALL EMERGENCY HVAC REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$42,850.00

DISCUSSION:

Ald. Susmarski inquired if this is the final HVAC work to be done. Director Lange said that this is all we have planned at this time. This work was not scheduled, but during inspection it found that the 2 existing roof top units were cracked. Rather than repairing it, it is more cost effective to replace them. No additional work is scheduled at this time, but other parts such as air handlers and other components may need to be replaced down the line. Currently we are working on an inspection schedule for all the roof top units. Ald. Jakabs inquired if we have a maintenance company that would have found this. Director Lange we have a contract with a maintenance company that inspects the units quarterly, and it was at that time the damage was located. The Mayor inquired if we were able to expand the system and connect the Police Department and City Hall systems. Director Lange stated that they are 2 separate systems and we would not be able to connect them.

Director Lange stated that it is scheduled to begin shortly after the project bid is accepted, which is October 6th.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff Recommends Approval of Purchase Agreements from Landmark Sign Group for Purchase and Installation of City Wayfinding and Entryway Signage in an Amount Not to Exceed \$50,421.

BACKGROUND:

The City Council, as part of the 2021 Strategic Planning Session, tasked staff with developing a wayfinding sign network throughout the City to identify key locations such as Park District, Library District, Fire District, and City facilities. Staff has been working with Landmark Sign Group who has provided previous signage with the City's branding to develop proofs and purchase agreements. The proposed locations, proofs, and purchase agreements of the wayfinding signs are attached, as is the proof and purchase agreement for the entryway sign to be installed near Irving Park Road and Edgewood Avenue.

ANALYSIS:

The total cost of the purchase agreements amounts to \$50,421. Staff budgeted \$75,000 within the Tourism Fund for Community Signage. Wayfinding signs will be mounted to existing streetlights where possible, however some locations may require new poles which would be purchased separately and installed by Public Works staff. The exact location of the Irving Park Road entryway sign will need to be coordinated with existing utilities, signage, driveways, sightlines, and trees. To avoid damage from plows, the sign will need to be located adequate distance from the roadway which may require temporary or permanent easements from private property owners.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff Recommends Approval of an Agreement between the City of Wood Dale and Crowne Tank ltd. for the Public Works Facility Fuel Replacement Project in an Amount Not to Exceed \$27,969.00.

BACKGROUND:

The City is currently undertaking the Public Works Facility Improvements Project. One aspect of this project is replacing one of the two fuel tanks due to its condition. The tank that is anticipated to be replaced will contain gasoline. The tank will include a new pump and gallon counting mechanism. The scope consists of delivery and installation costs. Bids were publicly advertised, and a bid opening was held on September 15, 2022. The bid was advertised in the Dailey Herald and sent to five tank installation contractors. One bid was received from Crown Industries, Itd.

ANALYSIS:

\$75,000 was budgeted within the CIP in FY 23 for fuel tank replacement costs associated with the Public Works Facility Improvements project. While only one bid was received, staff had previously obtained general budget numbers early on in the design phase of the Public Works Facility Improvement Project and find Crown Industries, ltd. bid submittal to be in line with anticipated costs for the completion of this work.

23. <u>ASSIGNMENT</u>: Assignment of this contract or any part thereof, or any funds to be received thereunder by the contractor shall be subject to written approval of the Owner.

The coverage afforded the additional insureds shall be primary insurance for the additional insureds with respect to claims or suits arising out of operations performed by or on behalf of the Contractor.

If the additional insures have other insurance which is applicable to the loss, such other insurance shall be on an excess or contingent basis. The amount of the company's liability under the insurance policy shall not be reduced by the existence of such other insurance.

A. Workers' Compensation and Employers' Liability Coverages

The insurer shall agree to waive all rights of subrogation against the City of Wood Dale, its officials, agents, employees and volunteers for losses arising from work performed by Contractor for the City of Wood Dale.

B. All Coverages

Each insurance policy required by this clause shall be endorsed to state that coverage shall not be suspended, voided, cancelled, reduced in coverage or in limits except after thirty (30) days prior written notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, has been given to the City.

C. Verification of Coverage

Contractor shall furnish the City with certificates of insurance naming the member, its officials, agents, employees and volunteers as additional insureds, and with original endorsements affecting coverage required by this clause. The certificates and endorsements for each insurance policy are to be signed by a person authorized by that insurer to bind coverage on its behalf. The certificates and endorsements may be on the forms provided by the City and are to be received and approved by the City before any work commences.

D. Assumption of Liability

The contractor assumes liability for all injury or death of any person or persons including employees of the contractor, or any sub-contractor, any supplier or any other person and assumes liability for all damage to property sustained by any person or persons so occasioned by or in any way arising out of any work performed pursuant to this agreement.

E. Regulatory Requirements

Contractor bidder must comply with all applicable laws, regulations, and rules promulgated by any Federal, State, County, Municipal and/or other governmental unit or regulatory body now in effect or which may be in effect during the performance of the work. INTERFERENCE WITH PUBLIC CONTRACTING - - BID RIGGING AND ROTATING - - KICKBACKS - - BRIBERY

PUBLIC ACT 85-1295 S.B. 2002

AN ACT to add Article 33E to the "Criminal Code of 1961", approved July 28, 1961, as amended. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly: Section 1: Article 33E is added to the "Criminal Code of 1961", approved July 28, 1961, as amended, the added Article to read as follows:

ARTICLE 33E. PUBLIC CONTRACTS

Sec. 33E-3 Bid-rigging. A person commits the offense of bid-rigging when he knowingly agrees with any person who is, or but for such agreement would be, a competitor of such person concerning any bid submitted or not submitted by such person or another to a unit of State or local government when with the intent that the bid submitted or not submitted will result in the award of a contract to such person or another and he either (1) Provides such person or receives, from another, information be disclosed to a competitor in an independent, noncollusive submission of bids or (2) Submits a bid that is off such a price, or other material terms, that he does not intend the bid to be accepted.

Bid-rigging is a Class 3 felony. Any person convicted of this offense shall be barred for 5 years from the date of conviction from bidding on any contract offered for bid by any unit of State or local government.

Sec 33E-4. Bid rotating. A person commits the offense of bid rotating when pursuant to any collusive scheme or agreement with another. He engages in a patter over time (which, for the purposes of this Section, shall include at least 3 contract bids within a period of 10 years, the most recent of which occurs after the effective date of this amendatory Act of 1988) of submitting sealed bids to units of State or local government with the intent that the award of such bids rotates, or is

distributed among persons or business entities which submit bids on a substantial number of the same contracts. Bid rotating is a Class 2 felony. Any person convicted of this offense shall be permanently barred from bidding on public contracts in the State of Illinois.



RECOMMENDATION:

Staff Recommends the approval of a purchase agreement between the City of Wood Dale and IT Savvy for the Mondo Board Project at City Hall and Public Works in an amount not to exceed \$23,200. The Mondo Boards will replace existing end of life equipment in the City Council Chambers and the Executive Session meeting room. This equipment will allow for Zoom meetings, Council presentations including the potential for interactive presentations at future meetings. The Mondo Boards purchased for the new Public Works Facility will also offer interactive training and conference meeting capability.

BACKGROUND:

The City has budgeted to install teleconference technology for the new Public Works facility and also upgrade the Council Chambers and Executive Session conference room for PEG access, teleconference, and video production technology.

ANALYSIS:

The City budgeted for technology upgrades during FY 2023. The Comcast PEG fee will fund the Mondo Boards for the Council Chambers and the PW Facility Improvement Project will fund the Public Works Mondo Boards. The Mondo Board technology items of this purchase agreement is valued at \$23,200.


