



**RESOLUTION NO. R-22-57**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A PROPOSAL FROM U.S. DISMANTLEMENT FOR THE DEMOLITION OF 372 N WOOD DALE ROAD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$66,000**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wood Dale (hereinafter referred to as the "City") is a duly organized and existing body politic and corporate governed by the provisions of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, *et seq.*, and its own duly adopted Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is authorized and empowered under the Illinois Municipal Code, and its Ordinances adopted pursuant thereto, to enter into agreements and to contract for goods and services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council of the City seek to ensure that the City is run effectively and efficiently; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council of the City, seeks the **U.S. DISMANTLEMENT** for the **DEMOLITION OF 372 N WOOD DALE ROAD**; and

**WHEREAS**, these services are necessary to maintain and promote an effective and efficient City Government; and

**WHEREAS**, after diligent review of the qualifications and services of **U.S. DISMANTLEMENT**, the Mayor and the City Council find **U.S. DISMANTLEMENT** is the most qualified firm to perform the duties sought by the City; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF WOOD DALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, AN ILLINOIS CORPORATION**, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**SECTION 2:** The Mayor is authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of the City of Wood Dale, which signature shall be attested to by the City Clerk.

**SECTION 3:** The City Manager, staff and/or the City Attorney shall take the steps necessary to put the terms and conditions of the Agreement into effect.

**SECTION 4:** That all ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Resolution are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**SECTION 5:** That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Gentlemen,

It is our understanding City Council approved the project above so this proposal letter will serve as our contract to complete the work when executed by both parties.

Proposal Price \$ 66,000

Scope of Work

USD will mobilize to the project jobsite and demolish the existing 1 story brick office building.

Prior to demolition, hazardous materials identified in True North Consultants reports (Fluorescent Bulbs, Ballasts, Mercury Thermostats, Smoke Detectors and Fire Extinguishers) will be removed and recycled/disposed of as universal waste.

Drive through structure will be demolished.

The parking lot and curbs will remain in place.

Concrete foundation will remain in place. Basement slabs on grade fractured to allow for drainage.

Hauling and disposal of all rubbish (drywall, ceilings, carpet, roofing materials, etc) unsuitable for backfill into the basement void is included.

Broken up solid debris (brick, concrete, asphalt, gravel) will be mixed and compacted into the basement void.

The demolition area (existing grass and trees not in the parking lot will remain as is).

Permits and all disconnects of utilities are assumed to be done by others.
