The Wood Dale Police Department is scheduled for an On-Site Assessment as part of a nationally recognized program to achieve accreditation by verifying that it meets strict professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc. (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the-art standards in four basic areas: policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the on-site assessment, agency employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a public information session held Monday, April 26, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. The session will be conducted in the City of Wood Dale Council Chambers, at 404 N. Wood Dale Road, Wood Dale, IL 60191.

Agency employees and the public are also invited to offer comments by calling (630) 787-3809 on Monday, April 26, 2010 between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

Telephone comments as well as appearances at the public information session are limited to 10 minutes and must address the police department's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
