








Step 1. Login to your my.wooddale.com Self-Service account.








Step 2. Under the "My Work" tab, review "My Licenses".




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


Step 3. Click "Renew" under the expired Commercial Occupancy Certificate.


USE/OCCUPANCY CLASSIFICATION: The types of use/occupancy include the following:

- A. <u>Day care/school</u>: The use of a structure or land for educational purposes or in which care or supervision is provided to persons who are not capable of self-preservation without physical assistance.
 - B. Lodging/residential: The use of a structure or land for sleeping purposes.
- C. <u>Manufacturing and research:</u> The use of a structure or land for assembling, disassembling, fabricating, finishing, manufacturing, packaging, repair or processing operations that are not considered a high hazard or storage use. This term includes the testing and study of materials and sources to establish facts and conclusions.
- D. <u>Professional offices:</u> The use of a structure or land for offices, professional or service-type transactions that are not considered retail/services.
- E. <u>Restaurant/bar/entertainment:</u> The use of a structure or land for the gathering of people for civic, social or religious functions, recreation, food or drink consumption.
- F. <u>Retail/services:</u> The use of a structure or land for the display and sale of merchandise and involves stocks of goods, wares or merchandise incidental to such purposes and open and accessible to the public. This term also includes the sale of services provided to the public on- site; examples include but are not limited to dry cleaning, hair salon, car wash, auto repair, etc.
- G. <u>Warehouse/freight forwarding/storage</u>: The use of a structure or land for or intended to be used for storage of materials, refuse, or vehicles, trailers and equipment not in service that is not classified as high hazard.
- H. **Gas station or other high hazard use**: The use of a structure or land that involves the manufacturing, processing, generation and storage of materials that constitute a physical or health hazard. Examples include but are not limited to gas stations and on-site dry cleaning.


VENDING MACHINE: Any coin operated device that dispenses anything of value including food, beverage, goods, wares, merchandise or services. Examples of vending machines include vacuum and air machines, movie and game rental (such as Redbox), musical devices (such as jukeboxes), newspaper dispensing machines, laundromat washers and dryers, spare change collection devices (such as Coinstar), stamping/engraving machines, etc


Use/Occupancy Classification based on City Code. All coinoperated/vending devices must also be registered.







Step 7. Add any relevant documents, such as lease agreements. If none applicable, click "Next".





Step 8. Review and submit. Please take the time to make any necessary changes related to keyholders, billing or main contacts.





Step 9. If successfully renewed, the above green box will appear.

Staff will review your renewal application and schedule an on-site inspection. Following a satisfactory inspection, an invoice will be generated. Following payment, a new COC will be issued and available through your self-service portal.
