

The Adopt-a-Drain program in Wood Dale is administered by the Public Works Department. Wood Dale's storm sewers are part of a system that the City maintains. However, assistance with maintenance from residents or group is greatly appreciated and welcomed.

Program Rules/Guidelines:

- 1. The City of Wood Dale will honor requests on a first-come, first-serve basis. The list of storm drains can be found by visiting the Adopt-a-Drain program page on the City's website. Please indicate the preference of storm drain location, based on accessibility to your own property or a City owned right of way. If there is a storm drain not listed, please reach out to verify if it is an adoptable drain.
- **2.** Liability insurance shall not be required. The adopting homeowner must accept responsibility for their own actions and hold harmless the City of Wood Dale.
- **3.** The homeowner/adoptee may **pause their adoption** due to vacation schedules or for being out of town for up to 30 days by contacting the Public Works Department at 630-350-3530.
- **4.** The homeowner/adoptee may **terminate their adoption** by directing a written request to the "City of Wood Dale, attention Department of Public Works Department", 404 N. Wood Dale Road, Wood Dale, IL 60191.
- 5. The homeowner/adoptee is responsible for keeping storm drains clear and reporting any issues with the drain. Homeowners should not remove grates or drain covers for any reason.
- **6.** The homeowner/adoptee is required to wear gloves and hard sole shoes when picking up litter. It is recommended to wear a safety vest if entering the roadway. The City will provide an Adopt-a-Drain welcome kit that includes safety vets, gloves and yard waste bags.
- 7. The homeowner/adoptee may obtain a welcoming kit during the work hours of the City of Wood Dale Public Works Department, 790 N Central, Monday to Friday 7:00 am to 3:30 pm.
- **8.** Any large objects, safety hazards or dead animals found should be reported to the Public Works Department.
