



Lump Sum Proposal for Cathodic Protection Services
City of Wood Dale pump station | AAJA-10A0PTH

Corrpro is pleased to provide our Lump Sum proposal to City of Wood Dale for the materials and installation of the Wood Dale pump station in Wood Dale IL.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. Pre-Installation / Project Preparation

- a. Order materials
- b. Place 811 notification calls for each site.
- c. Confirm all materials delivered.

2. Installation

- a. Install 4 supplemental Ramanode anodes replacing existing depleted anodes
- b. Install new #8 AWG header cable
- c. Splice anode leads to new header cable
- d. Install new 20v/ 5a rectifier.
- e. Utilize existing negative if it is continuous to the station if not replace.

4. System Commissioning

- a. Corrpro will provide a NACE Certified Corrosion Technician to commission the Cathodic Protection System
 - i. Measure Native potentials.
 - ii. Electrical Isolation Tests
 - iii. Measure and record "On" and "Instant-Off" potentials at predesignated test point locations
 - iv. Measure final Anode outputs.
 - v. Adjust rectifiers as necessary.
- b. Once all onsite commissioning procedures have been completed Corrpro will provide a commissioning report that will include the following:
 - vi. Results of testing
 - vii. Recommendations

3. Closeout

- a. Field dress site
- b. Provide City of Wood Dale with as-built drawings in AutoCAD


1. The right of ingress, egress, and access to all properties necessary for completion of the work to be provided by others. Delays and costs associated with right-of-way or access problems will incur additional charges.
2. Utilizing existing negatives.
3. All work areas will be field dressed. Asphalt, additional gravel, grass, sod, crop damage or replacement, etc. are not included.
4. Corrpro is not responsible for locating and repairing any utility lines not affiliated with the One Call system, and therefore considered un-locatable, nor are responsible for any damage that may occur. This would include such items as irrigation systems, sewer service lines, water service lines, satellite lines, private electric lines, private gas lines, pool line, underground security fences, etc.
City of Wood Dale is required to locate all owned underground assets.
5. Commissioning is to be provided By Corrpro.
6. Matting, hydro-excavations, and spoil disposal is to be provided by City of Wood Dale if required.

QUALIFIERS

1. Corrpro will bill for materials and installation after the completion.
2. Any additional scope of work items requested, not included in Corrpro's proposal will be charged according to the rates contained in the 2022 Corrpro Standard Rate Sheet .
3. Any standby time that applies to work stoppages beyond Corrpro's control to include, but not limited to, drilling delays, customer directives, services provided by others, or access issues will be charged according to the rates contained in the MSA # referenced above or 2022 Corrpro Standard Rate Sheet.
4. Corrpro shall not execute any work not outlined in this quote without a fully executed Change Order.
5. Material pricing includes items listed under the Bill of Material section of this document. Corrpro will supply additional materials to complete this installation at cost plus 15%.
6. Material lead times for rectifiers and junction boxes are 6-8 weeks from the time the order is submitted.
7. Materials are a commodity whose price is volatile on markets. The prices quoted are based on the present value of associated materials. In the event of a change in price greater than 5% for any item, Corrpro's pricing is subject to change at time of order placement.
8. City of Wood Dale is to supply a tax exemption and/or direct pay certificate if applicable.
