

**ORDINANCE NO. O-23-017**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE CITY OF WOOD DALE  
MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDING THE TIME FRAME FOR PLACEMENT OF REFUSE  
CARTS FOR COLLECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wood Dale (hereinafter referred to as the “City”) is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*; and

**WHEREAS**, the City possesses the authority, pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*, to adopt ordinances pertaining to public health, safety and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City (hereinafter referred to as the “City Council”) is the corporate authority for the City and is authorized by law to exercise all powers and to control the affairs of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council possesses full power and authority to approve and pass all ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations necessary for carrying into effect the objects for which the City was formed, in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Code (the “Code”) currently regulates and controls all matters concerning the general health and safety of residents and visitors within the City; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 6.303.A.1 of the Code currently provides that refuse carts shall be placed for collection no earlier than six o’clock (6:00 P.M.) the day before refuse collection; and

**WHEREAS**, during the winter seasons, public health and safety concerns, such as limited visibility, can adversely impact residents who place refuse carts for collection the day before scheduled collection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that providing for earlier placement of refuse carts the day before scheduled collection is in the best interests of the City and its residents to enhance the public health and safety of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed change to the time of refuse cart placement will not result in additional debris nor will it adversely affect the aesthetics of the neighborhood and will enhance the safety of the City’s most vulnerable residents in placing refuse carts at the curb without incident; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and the City Council believe it to be necessary and proper that the City Council adopt the amendment to Chapter 6 of the Code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois, at a special meeting duly assembled, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** That the recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**SECTION TWO:** That Chapters 6 of the Code is hereby amended as follows:

**Sec. 6.303. Mandatory Collection Of Refuse**

**A. Buildings Containing One Or Two Residential Dwelling Units**

1. On the assigned day for pick up, the subscriber shall place or cause to be placed at the curb all refuse to be collected. It shall be unlawful for any person to deposit garbage or refuse or garbage containers or any metal container in any street, alley or public way except for a period no earlier than ~~six~~ four o'clock (~~6:00~~ 4:00) P.M. the day before scheduled collection, nor later than eight o'clock (8:00) P.M. the day of collection. At all other times, the garbage or refuse of any kind or garbage containers or metal containers of any kind shall be stored in the rear of the premises.

**SECTION THREE:** That all ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**SECTION FOUR:** That the City Manager, City Staff and City Attorney shall take all steps necessary or authorized to implement said provisions.

**SECTION FIVE:** That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form, pursuant to the statutes of the State of Illinois.

**SECTION SIX:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.
