Death Investigation

Wood Dale, IL – The Wood Dale Police Department responded to a residence in the 100 block of Maple Avenue at approximately 9:57am, along with the Wood Dale Fire Department. The caller had reported that a 14 year old male was found in the residence and was not breathing.

The 14 year old male resident of the house, a Fenton High School student, was located in the residence and was pronounced dead at the scene.

The investigation into the circumstances surrounding this incident is ongoing, and the department is working with the DuPage County Coroner's office to determine the cause of death. There is no indication of foul play at this point in the investigation, and there is no concern for the public safety.

The department notified Fenton High School to advise them of the sudden death of one of their students. Any questions regarding the grief protocols being followed by the school should be directed to their attention.

The name of the 14 year old is not being released at this time.
