Burglary

Barricaded Subject:

Wood Dale, IL – The Wood Dale Police Department had experienced several residential burglaries in the area that led investigators to three suspects in the last day. Two of the suspects were located in the early morning hours on April 17, 2015. There was information that the third suspect was staying at a residence in the 400 block of Maple Street in Wood Dale. It was also believed the third suspect was in possession of a handgun taken from one of the burglaries.

Wood Dale Police units responded to the Maple residence and made numerous attempts to contact the burglary suspect to bring about his peaceful surrender. The suspect refused all contact and the Du Page Felony Investigative Assistance Team sent a SWAT unit to assist in the situation. SWAT was able to make contact with the suspect in the residence that led to a peaceful resolution.

We will release the names of the three suspects at the conclusion of our investigation and pending formal charges.
