
IV. REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION:

A. Update on White Oaks Park Project

Mr. Ellmann reported that the Park District has applied for the OSLAD grant and expects to hear any day whether they have been invited to Springfield to present. If they are invited to present, it will be another couple of weeks before they hear if they have been awarded the grant. Mr. Ellmann also reported that staff is working on value engineering the building in an effort to attract more competitive bids. The Park District will go out to bid in the next couple of weeks on the construction of phase #1 of the site's re-development project.

B. Update on Mittel Drive Extension Project

Ms. Buggy reported that per the direction of the City Council, the City Attorney is having an appraisal conducted of the Park District property located at Wood Dale Road and Sivert Drive. Once the appraisal is completed, an assessment will be conducted and the results will be taken to the Council for further discussion and direction. Ms. Buggy also noted that City staff and HR Green met with the School District Superintendent, Board President, and Board Vice President to





discuss if there was any interest from the School District Board in permitting the City to procure their property. Those present noted that the Board's main concern is the safety of the children, but that they are open to further discussions.

- C. Update and Discussion on Joint Special Events
 - Movies in the Park
 Ms. Buggy reported that the City's Special Events Committee has determined
 that it would like the City to coordinate with the Park District on four movies
 during the 2019 season. The Marketing and Special Events Manager will
 reach out to Park District staff in the next few weeks to begin planning titles
 and dates.
 - Other Events
 Ms. Buggy noted that the City's next big event will be the Memorial Day Parade. Smaller upcoming events include Arbor Day and the Green Fair.

A. Other Items

1. Meeting Schedule

As it was the first meeting of 2019, the Committee was asked to discuss whether meetings should continue to be held on the second Tuesday of the month at 6:30 p.m. The members agreed that this meeting schedule should continue. The Committee was also asked to discuss whether there was any interest in going to bi-monthly or quarterly meetings. Alderman Woods suggested that the meetings should continue to be scheduled monthly so members save those dates on their calendars; then, if there is a lack of material for discussion, a meeting can be cancelled as needed. The other Committee members agreed. The Committee also determined that meetings should be held regularly at City Hall, instead of switching back and forth to the Park District Recreation Center. Ms. Buggy stated that she would send out a recurring Outlook invite so Committee members can save the meeting schedule in their calendars.
