## ORDINANCE NO. O-19-011

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF A PROMISSORY NOTE OF THE CITY OF WOOD DALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Section 8-1-3.1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/8-1-3.1) (the "Code") authorizes the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois (the "City") to borrow funds from any bank or financial institution provided such funds shall be repaid within ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, the City previously issued its \$5,000,000 Promissory Note, Series 2016, dated June 2, 2016 (the "Note"), in favor of Schaumburg Bank & Trust Company N.A. (the "Bank") evidencing indebtedness of the City pursuant to the line of credit by the Bank (the "Loan"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City (the "Corporate Authorities") have heretofore and it hereby expressly is determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the City and its citizens to renew the Loan (the "Renewal"); and

WHEREAS, the maturity date of the Note needs to be extended to June 2, 2022 (the "Extension").

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Alderman of the City of Wood Dale, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. Extension. The maturity date of the Note is hereby extended to June 2, 2022.
