



ORDINANCE NO. O-18-021

AN ORDINANCE ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR
LABORERS, WORKMEN AND MECHANICS EMPLOYED IN PUBLIC WORKS OF
THE CITY OF WOOD DALE

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "The Prevailing Wage Act", being 820 ILCS 130/0.01, et seq. (herein "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the City Council of the City of Wood Dale investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said City of Wood Dale employed in performing construction of public works, for said City of Wood Dale;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOOD DALE, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION ONE: That, to the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the City of Wood Dale is hereby ascertained and determine to be the same as the Federal minimum rate of wages attached hereto as Exhibit A.

SECTION TWO: That nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the City of Wood Dale to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION THREE: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale is directed hereby to publicly post or keep available for inspection, by any interested party, in City Hall of the City of Wood Dale this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

SECTION FOUR: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale is directed hereby to mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION FIVE: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale is directed hereby to promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.


SECTION SIX: That the City Clerk of the City of Wood Dale is directed hereby to cause a copy of this Ordinance to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Wood Dale, and such publication shall constitute notice that this determination is effective and that this is the determination of the City Council of the City of Wood Dale.

SECTION SEVEN: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in the manner provided by law.


