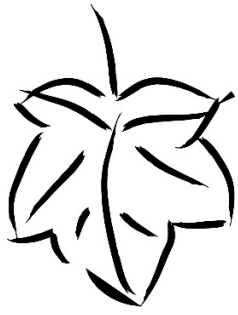

DISCUSSION:

Gail Bedard had several discussion items before the meeting, and Deputy Chief O'Neil related the responses from Assistant Public Works Hastings. The first item was on the maintenance of facilities and waterways. The City will have regular cleaning of the system, and the Wastewater Division will operate and maintain the lift station for the new stormwater detention system. The second item discussed was the Vactor truck clean out the Forest View BERM pipes, and Public works will continue to clean the lines. The last discussion item was about newly planted trees on Forest View.



These trees are directly under the powerlines. The City of Wood Dale did not plant the trees, and Public Works will investigate.

There was an open discussion about the Flooding Action plan.

Alderman Eugene Wesley and Alderman Tony Catalano spoke in detail about Ward 2/3 bid and continuation of the Stormwater project. Details were explained about the underground water detention that will be held at Westview School 200 N. Addison Rd.
