REZONING UPON ANNEXATION FROM R-1 TO R-2 FOR 382 E. DEERPATH ROAD (FORMERLY KNOWN AS 17W271 DEERPATH ROAD)

Manager Mermuys reported that his matter comes from the Council's Program of a \$5,000 annexation incentive. It is a vacant lot with no controversy from Public Comment at the CDC Meeting. Annexed property is automatically classified as R-1 Zoning. All the surrounding lots in this area are zoned R-2. In order to be consistent with the neighborhood, the Council is being asked to rezone the annexed Property from R-1 to R-2 for a single family home in Wood Dale.
