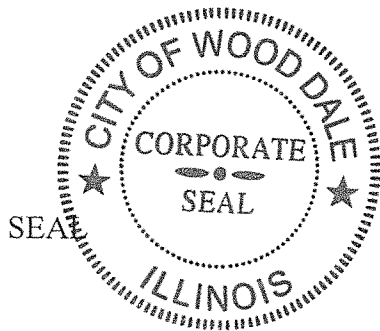

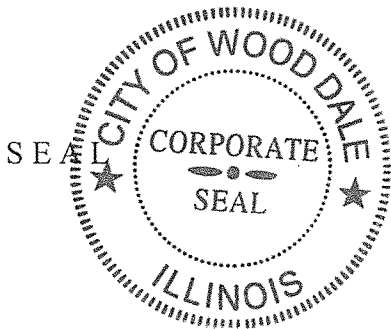

RESOLUTION NO. R-21-65

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WOOD DALE PARTICIPATION IN
THE 2021 SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Wood Dale (hereinafter the "City") is a body politic and corporate, organized and existing pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the City possesses the authority, pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1 *et seq.*, to adopt ordinances and resolutions pertaining to the public health, safety and welfare of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City (hereinafter referred to as the "City Council") is the corporate authority for the City and is authorized by law to exercise all powers and to control the affairs of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council possesses full power and authority to approve and pass all necessary ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations necessary for carrying into effect the objects for which the City was formed, in accordance with the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City of is responsible for the construction and repair of various forms of transportation infrastructure within its right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to extend the Salt Creek-Greenway Trail from the Forest Preserve property entrance to Wood Dale Road along Elizabeth Drive, one of only two routes crossing Salt Creek within the City's municipal limits; and

WHEREAS, Oakbrook Elementary School, operated by Wood Dale School District 7, is located just north of Elizabeth Drive on Wood Dale Road in Wood Dale, and serves portions of the City west of Salt Creek; and

WHEREAS, the City, with the support of School District 7, seeks to provide safe alternative travel routes to Oakbrook Elementary for pedestrian and bike travel; and

WHEREAS, the City and its consultants have the necessary experience in administering Grants of similar scope and capacity and personnel capable of ensuring Program delivery; and

WHEREAS, the City Council fully supports the submittal of an Application to the Illinois Department of Transportation for participation in the Safe Routes to School Program to help fund said improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF WOOD DALE, DUPAGE COUNTY, AN ILLINOIS CORPORATION, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign the Application and various forms contained therein, make all required submissions, and do all things necessary to complete the Application for the funds requested in the recitals of this Resolution.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor is hereby authorized to certify that matching funds which have been identified as supporting its Projects, as set out within its Application, will be made available upon the Approval of the Projects by the County of DuPage, or the prorated share thereof.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law. If any portion of this Resolution is invalid, that portion shall be stricken from this Resolution and the remainder of this Resolution shall continue in full force and effect to the extent possible.


